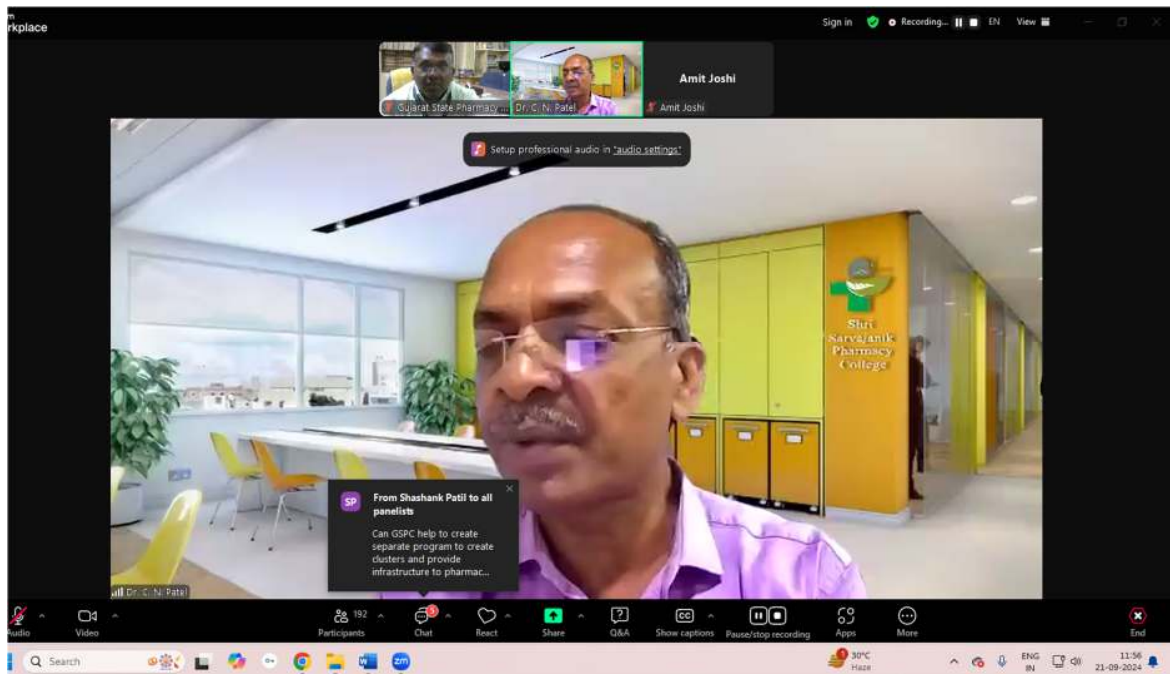
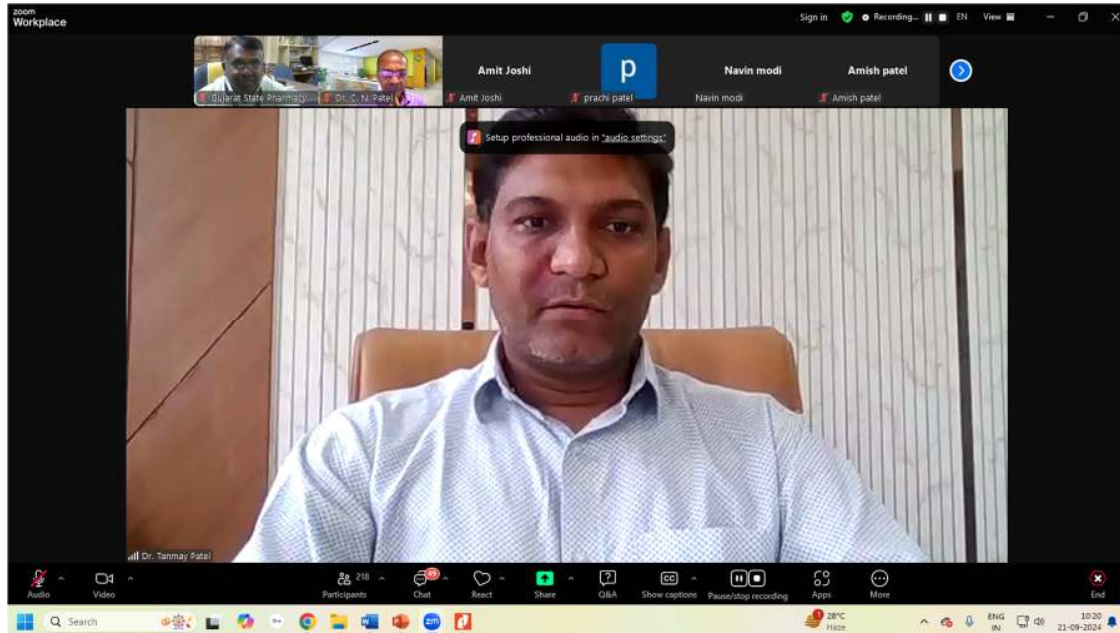
1. **Prescription Handling**
